**Are You Ready**? We have a mission. Your United Way is working hard every day to make a brighter future for each and every one of us. Our mission requires us to Live United daily.

Your local United Way achieved yet another record-breaking milestone in FY 2023 by securing over \$1 Million in funds. As of June 30, 2023, \$1,397,116 was pledged from thousands of individual donors, corporations and grants. All of these monies are invested in local programs to improve the lives of our friends and neighbors.

Together we are making a difference and have created a tremendous amount of positive momentum. As you'll read throughout the pages of this report, we've added new certified partner agencies, expanded our community impact program, and administered \$359,832 in Covid relief funds in an 8-month span for Pasquotank County residents. Along the way, new Board Directors have joined the cause and we've had a lot of fun engaging the community with several signature events.

Our biggest event, Bocce, Beer & Bites was another tremendous success. We sold out of tournament teams after expanding to 10 courts and 48 teams in 2023. Make plans to join us on April 27, 2024, at Waterfront Park. Ping Pong down Paradise Plunge at H20BX was again a fun way to support AAUW during the height of summertime fun. Our special jersey night at the Edenton Steamers, complete with Fireworks, surpassed last year's all-time record. We're especially thankful for organizations like Albemarle Area Association of Realtors (AAAR) who raised over \$16,000 in a single night for AAUW.

While we have accomplished much, the mission isn't completed. I encourage you to LIVE UNITED. Together we can solve problems that are too big for any of us to solve alone. 




# **COMMUNITY CARE COLLABORATIVE**

The Community Care Collaborative (CCC) has continued to be a great need in our rural NENC area. We continue to bring new neighbors into the CCC family by adding to our advisory board, expanding our list of supporters, and working with more than 20 social service partner agencies.

With the help of Jon Hawley, our Covid-19 CDBG grant has helped 326 families in Pasquotank County stay in safe homes. With your support, CCC has helped over 446 families in Perquimans, Pasquotank, Camden, and Gates Counties avoid eviction, keep their lights on, and continue on the path to success.

Through the kindness and conviction of our volunteers, advisory committee, church supporters, individual donors, and corporate donors, CCC is making a notable difference in our community. 
